



**J. MILTON HUTSON, M.D.**

Dr. J. Milton Hutson is an Attending Obstetrician and Gynecologist at NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital/Weill Cornell Medical Center and an Assistant Professor of Clinical Obstetrics and Gynecology at Weill Cornell Medical College.

Dr. Hutson was born in Decatur, Alabama and earned a B.S. in Biology, Chemistry and Computer Science at The University of Alabama. He then went on to earn an M.D. at The University of Alabama School of Medicine where he was awarded the J. Marion Sims Award for Excellence in Obstetrics and Gynecology in 1975. He completed his residency at The University of Cincinnati Medical Center in 1979, serving as Chief Resident. After one year on the faculty at Wayne State University in Detroit, he came to New York and completed a fellowship in Maternal-Fetal Medicine in 1982 at the Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons and subsequently joined the faculty at NewYork-Presbyterian/Columbia University Medical Center's Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology. In 1984, he joined the full-time faculty at the former New York Hospital/Cornell Medical Center in the Maternal-Fetal Medicine division of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology.

His areas of expertise include amniocentesis, obstetrical care of multiple gestations and cervical insufficiency and he performed the first multi-fetal pregnancy reduction procedures at the former New York Hospital. In 1990, he joined the voluntary attending staff and continues with an active practice of high-risk obstetrics patients. He has been named in *New York Magazine's* "Best Doctors" list multiple times and has been one of *Castle Connelly's* "Top Doctors in New York" for 17 straight years.

Dr. Hutson and wife Joan, a Maternal-Fetal Medicine nurse, reside in New York City and Southold, New York with their two wonderful dogs Hinckley and Benny. He has one daughter, Sophia, who recently received her MBA from Columbia Business School.



**ROBIN B. KALISH, M.D.**

Dr. Robin Kalish is an Associate Attending Obstetrician and Gynecologist at NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital/Weill Cornell Medical Center, an Associate Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Weill Cornell Medical College and Director of Clinical Maternal-Fetal Medicine at Weill Cornell Medicine. She is board certified in Obstetrics and Gynecology as well as Maternal-Fetal Medicine. A graduate of Dartmouth College, Dr. Kalish received a B.A. in Psychology and her M.D. from The University of Tennessee College of Medicine. She completed her residency in Obstetrics and Gynecology at Winthrop-University Hospital in Mineola, NY and her fellowship in Maternal-Fetal Medicine at the former Weill Cornell Medical College. She has held a faculty appointment at Weill Cornell Medical College since 2003.

Dr. Kalish specializes in high-risk obstetrics. She cares for women with medical conditions such as diabetes, hypertension and lupus as well as women who conceived through in vitro fertilization or have multifetal pregnancies. In addition, she specializes in obstetric ultrasound and prenatal diagnosis including amniocentesis and chorionic villus sampling.

As a practitioner, faculty member and researcher, Dr. Kalish is one of the reasons NewYork-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell Medical Center is regarded as one of the foremost teaching hospitals in the world, leading not just in the advancement of patient care but also in the development of future leaders of medicine. She has been a recipient of the Chief Resident Teaching Award, has been named in *New York Magazine's* "Best Doctors" list multiple times and is a member of the New York Obstetrical Society. Since joining Weill Cornell Medical College, Dr. Kalish has collaborated on and published more than fifty peer-reviewed medical journal research articles. She has presented her research at the Society for Maternal-Fetal Medicine scientific meeting every year for the past fifteen years. She is also actively involved in teaching, training and supervising medical students, obstetric residents and Maternal-Fetal Medicine fellows.
