### **ANNE T. CARLON, M.D.**

Anne Carlon, née Corsa, is an Assistant Attending Obstetrician and Gynecologist at NewYork-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell Medical Center as well as a Clinical Instructor in Obstetrics and Gynecology at Weill Cornell School of Medicine. Dr. Carlon has an active private practice of Obstetrics and Gynecology, with a particular interest in the care of women who have had breast malignancy. Dr. Carlon is also involved with tutoring and administering examinations to Weill Cornell medical students.

She grew up in Farmingdale, on Long Island. She graduated *magna cum laude* from Brown University with an A.B. in Human Biology and Psychology and attended medical school at Duke University, where she obtained her M.D. in 1983. She returned to New York for her residency in Obstetrics and Gynecology at NewYork-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell, which she completed in 1987. She joined the voluntary staff of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology of NewYork-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell in 1987, and she has remained there ever since.

Dr. Carlon lives in New York City with her husband, who is also a physician. Together they have four sons, one of whom is a medical student at the University of Pennsylvania.

### **ANDREA DOBRENIS, M.D.**

Dr. Andrea Dobrenis is an Attending Obstetrician and Gynecologist at NewYork-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell and a Clinical Instructor in Obstetrics and Gynecology at Weill Cornell Medical College. A Cornellian her entire adult life, Dr. Dobrenis earned her Bachelor of Science in Biology with honors and distinction in 1983 and her M.D. in 1988. She was elected to membership in the Honor Medical Society Alpha Omega Alpha and was awarded the Janet M. Glasgow Memorial Achievement Citation by the American Medical Women's Association for scholastic achievement. During her tenure at Cornell University Medical College, she spent one year as a research assistant investigating factors affecting fertilization and as the lab technician in the new, now world-renowned IVF program.

Dr. Dobrenis went on to complete her residency training in Obstetrics and Gynecology at NewYork-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell in 1992 and thereafter joined the faculty of the department of Obstetrics and Gynecology. She is a three time recipient of the Chief Resident Teaching Award and was named as one of *New York Magazine's* "Top Doctors" in 2014.

Currently she practices General Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Iris Cantor Women's Health Center and resides in Westchester with her husband Dr. Kostantin Dobrenis, a Neuroscientist and professor. They have three grown children Kristen, Justin, and Dylan, all of whom were born at NewYork-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell.
